

ORDINANCE NO. 2018-800

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF POLK CITY, IOWA, BY AMENDING PROVISIONS OF THE ORDINANCE REGARDING FIREWORKS USE

WHEREAS, the City of Polk City deems the use of certain consumer fireworks as a threat to public safety and a nuisance to landowners.

BE IT ENACTED by the City Council of the City of Polk City, Iowa:


SECTION 1. Section 41.11 Fireworks, 2. Regulations, is hereby amended by deleting the current regulations and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- A. Except between 9:00 a.m. – 10:00 p.m. on July 3 and except between 9:00 a.m. – 11:00 p.m. on July 4 where persons 18 years and older may use or explode, it shall be unlawful for any person to use or explode any explosive, explosive material, First-class Consumer Fireworks or Second-class Consumer Fireworks within the corporate limits of the City.
- B. It shall be unlawful for any person to use or explode any Display Fireworks within the corporate limits of the City unless, upon application in writing, the City has issued a permit to a City agency, fair association, amusement park or other organizations or groups of individuals approved by City authorities to display fireworks and such display will be handled by a competent operator.


SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall be effective upon its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
